MSTS EMD Electro Motive JT42CWR

The Electro-Motive Diesel (EMD) JT42CWR (or Series 66) is a series of Co-Co diesel locomotives built by EMD for the European heavy freight market. Originally designed for use in Great Britain as the Class 66, a development of the Class 59, they have since been adapted and certified for use in other European countries. Outside of Europe, 40 locomotives have been sold to Egyptian Railways for passenger operation.

The locomotive uses standard EMD components of its era - an EMD 710 prime mover, D43 traction motors, radial (self-steering) bogies of patented design which reduces wheel surface and flange wear and is also said to improve adhesion and reduce track load.
