### **List of the scenarios**

The asterisk next to the title allows you to locate easily the scenario(s) containing at least one payware content.

#### **01) An old regional train to Wildau\*** ( )

Summary: Welcome on board of this regional train to Wildau ! You will drive this P8 steam engine until its destination. Stop in all stations.

Date: April 14, 1965

Duration: 30 minutes

#### **02) Back to the TEE times-1\*** ( )

Summary: The TEE between Dortmund and Brussels has been diverted through Altenburg and Luxemburg. Drive it as far as Bad Rinckenburg where another driver will replace you.

Date: September 9, 1964

Duration: 30 minutes

### 03) Back to the TEE times-2\* ( )

Summary: A TEE train has just arrived from Luxemburg in Bad Rinckenburg. You will now drive it between this station and Altenburg calling in Köblitz.

Date: April 30, 1977

Duration: 20 minutes

### 04) Köf and wood\* ( )

Summary: You have to shunt some wagons along the line between Köblitz and St Rudolf.

Date: August 16, 1972

Duration: 50 minutes

### 05) Young visitors from the East\* ( )

Summary: Sometimes in this Cold War, some exchange between West and East was possible. That's what occurs today. In Wildau people are waiting for a train from DDR. The children aboard will spend one week in this small city. You will drive this train from Altenburg.

Date: October 4, 1976

Duration: 55 minutes

## **Installation**

These scenarios are packaged in the same ".rwp" file. Install it through the Train Simulator 2012 package manager. These scenarios were created on the version 1.2 of the route. They may not work with previous route versions.
