Summary: A freight train from Ashington has to be filled with coal.

Duration: 75 minutes

04) Goods on tracks* ()

Summary: Two different tasks are waiting you.

Date: July 14, 1983

Duration: 45 minutes

Duration: 65 minutes

Summary: This winter is very hard and much oil than usual is necessary to warm the houses. You will drive a special tank train from Percy to Ashington.
